2012	July 2012: Groundbreaking for the Woods development on July 31. October 2012: The dry weather we have been having has allowed the contractor to make good progress on the site and infrastructure development. Property site manager expects infrastructure development should be complete by early November (weather permitting). This will allow construction of some of the homes to begin in early 2013. As of 5/23/2013, 7 of 19 total units are underway at various stages: Siding (units 2,5), Framing (unit 3), Foundation (units 7, 9), Slab (unit 6), Permit (unit 4). Agency estimates completion of all units by July 2014.
