

PIERCE COUNTY LEOFF 1 DISABILITY BOARD
POLICY FOR PAYMENT FOR THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG VIAGRA AND OTHER
PRESCRIBED SAME CLASS FOR SAME PURPOSE DRUGS

Claims for payment of up to a total of eight (8) units/dosages of Viagra or other prescribed same class, same purpose drugs (i.e. Levitra) per 30 day period may be honored by LEOFF 1 employers under the jurisdiction of the Pierce County LEOFF Disability Board. Payment of such claims is subject to the following criteria:

- The prescription drug Viagra or other same class for same purpose drugs, as described above, will be allowed when prescribed for a member by his/her attending physician.
- Claims must be filed with the member's employer or the employer's insurance carrier.
- Claims must be submitted within six months of filling the prescription, or as directed by the employer's insurance carrier.
- Claims must reflect the difference between the cost of the prescription and the amount covered by insurance, if any.

As in all other such matters, disputed claims may be submitted to the Board for consideration and appropriate action.
