New Business:

A. Pierce College AEMT program application

An AEMT program application through Pierce College was reviewed. The program is an eight (8) week course with 205 hours and 15 credits. Students will receive a PHTLS certificate for 16 hours. This course is in collaboration with the military. There is no real standard mode of education in the military. This program gives the military personnel an immediate job opportunity when they exit the military. The program adopts national standards for clinicals. The committee voted to approve the program application.

EMScconnect Training:

The online training program, EMScconnect, was viewed by webinar. The training can be done individually or as a group. The cost is \$6.00 per month per person. Each person has their own account; however, they are connected through each agency. Supervisors can see the training completed for their agency. The content of the trainings match the National Registry. Certificates can be viewed as a pdf and printed. You can retake the exam as many times as you want; however, you cannot access the exam unless you watch at least 75% of the course. The passing grade for tests is 80%. Because skills training is hands on, it is not taught online, however you can track or document it after completion. Agency leaders can generate reports on crew progress and testing.
